

TRUMP NATIONAL GOLF CLUB

Bedminster, NJ

The Trump National Golf Course located in Bedminster, NJ, which opened in September 2004, consists of an 18-hole course designed by Tom Fazio, one of the world's best golf course architects. Also on site are practice facilities that include a three-tiered driving range; a short game facility with two practice greens; and six additional practice greens.

The tees and greens at this prestigious course were constructed with a rootzone mix that included 80% USGA specific sand and 20% Agresoil™ biosolids compost from the Burlington County Co-Compost Facility in Columbus, NJ. The addition of Agresoil™ to the rootzone mix was chosen due to its consistency, high organic matter content and proven track record as an organic amendment in golf green construction.

Utilizing Agresoil™ as an organic amendment provides additional benefits traditional soil amendments, such as peat, cannot supply. These benefits include the addition of beneficial microbes and available nutrients. These essential elements aid in the development of a soil system that will promote healthy turfgrass growth in high maintenance areas.
