PEDDIE SCHOOL ATHLETIC FACILITIES

Hightstown, NJ

Peddie School, located in Highstown, NJ, is one of the northeast's most prestigious private high schools. Bordering Peddie Lake, the school's campus features 230 acres landscaped with trees, lawns and athletic fields.

In the Fall of 2004, renovations began on the school's athletic fields which include a softball field; four soccer fields; three lacrosse fields; and a field hockey field. During the first phase of renovations in September of 2004, 600 cubic yards of Agresoil[™] (formerly AllGro) biosolids compost was delivered directly to the school where it was mixed with sand and on-site soil to prepare a new rootzone mix for the fields; the second phase, completed in August of 2006, utilized 1,300 cubic yards of Agresoil[™] in the same manner.

Agresoil[™] was chosen for this project because of its ability to increase soil organic matter and provide nutrients. These elements aid in the development of a soil system that will promote healthy turfgrass growth in high maintenance areas.
